We appreciate the Lord's provision for the last 3 ½ years that He has blessed us with through other believers from different communities in our area at the Garden of Eden. We have been able to continue and increase our support of the mission work that we are part of in different countries and through the teaching of the five-fold ministry that God appointed to lead the church after the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ and the persecution from religion and government in their own communities, He has revealed to believers living in different communities throughout our area, the need for them to represent Christ to those in the community He has positioned them in.

We are grateful for having had the opportunity to live on this property and to have the Garden available to us and for the relationships we have been given because of it. It has also given those in our sphere of influence 3 ½ years to make their decision and use that opportunity to make their own choice and everyone has. Jesus gave those that followed Him that same opportunity, responsibility and choice and He is not angry because they choose to stay with the religion that they trust and neither is He now. Many are called and few are chosen. We know this was given to us to examine the cost that would be required to "deny ourselves and pick up our cross daily and follow Him." We know that the letters that Paul and Jesus wrote were written to believers that met together in the homes of believers that God appointed for the purpose of showing the unconditional love of the Father through Jesus Christ to everyone.

We had our last Sunday afternoon fellowship (Salt & Light) last month and are now continuing that fellowship at 3pm on Sundays through the grace and invitation of the New Life at the Well at 123 Evergreen off Riverside Drive in Mount Vernon. You are welcome. One of the limitations of serving God's people from a set location and property is the time it robs us of really walking the journey of faith in closer relationship with those that we serve. We already feel much closer to everyone that has visited or attended for any period of time and are anticipating a renewed and refreshed spirit of unity being given to everyone.

Linda, Ronaldo and I will be living and ministering to different communities from the home of Mike and Pam Westberg, 7777 Russell Road in Birdsvew, WA. During December, we will continue having the Harvest Kids meeting the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month at the Garden of Eden. After that, the Harvest Kids will be meeting on different days and times in one form or another to help the families and children in each community. We will communicate these as the locations are verified.

The Holy Spirit will teach those that God has appointed to serve Him in that capacity.

Many thanks to each of you who pray and provide the financial resources needed to reach the broken-hearted and crushed in spirit in our local communities and around the world. Harvest Vision Ministries will continue to serve financially to continue and expand the mission work and provide support to the church families as they grow and share with each other. We operate totally on a volunteer basis and no one receives any compensation for the labor that is required to over-see the ministry. All monies go to our co-laborers that are actively reaching the lost and teaching new believers to be true disciples in the various harvest fields He has called us to. We will be available to prepare and equip each one for the work that God has prepared in advance for them to do through the God appointed leadership He has entrusted to us in the New Testament. Harvest Kids has been an absolute joy. Harvest Kids is expanding by second. The Harvest Kids have been crushing lots of aluminum cans. We have deployed almost all the stands for collecting aluminum cans. Also continuing to prepare for Harvest Kids after December. Doing it more locally and in the homes of the trusted believers in Christ that it explains in Acts 4:32-35. The Harvest Kids are currently at \$1,749 for the Busolwe eastern Uganda, children's church. It's an absolute honor to see the Harvest Kids grow more in Christ. The reason for all this started is because a young 4-year-old girl thought her friends in Africa should have beds too. What an amazing vision the Lord gave this young girl. It all sparked the mind of a four-year-old. It's vital that we empower the young ones to do what the Lord has called them to do. We all have a divine calling and purpose for our lives. We must follow Christ and trust in Him. It's our responsibility to guide the young ones in the ways of the Lord because if we don't teach them to obey and follow God's word. Someone else will teach them what Christ isn't. "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity. Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to preaching and to teaching." (1 Timothy 4:12-13). Thanks to all who have been a part of helping the Harvest Kids fulfill the vision which God has appointed.

Thanks to our co-laborers and friends that bring their aluminum cans for the Harvest Kids to recycle. All the monies from their ministry support Comfort Africa in Uganda. The ministry finds families in Africa that have opened their homes to orphans in their community. Although the money is not sufficient to take care of their needs, it is a gesture that honors their unselfish love that these orphans receive from their sacrifices.

## Mexico

Olivia shared they are preaching at the Bethesda church family on Friday, in prayer at the Puerta Estrecha (Narrow Door) church family on Tuesday and helping another local church family that has started a feeding ministry on Saturdays. Olivia teaches the Word of God every Sunday to the children that are a part of the same church family that started the feeding ministry. This month she has also been sewing for her daughter's wedding in January and transporting her grandchildren back and forth to school during the week. The outreach in south Mexico with Pr. Obed and his family continues to share the love of Jesus at every opportunity. We are thankful that whenever there is a need in San Luis, Sonora or Guayemo, Guerrero, Mexico, that Miguel, Olivia, Obed and Zury will always be available with the right hand of fellowship, the good news of the gospel, a listening ear and a loving heart. ## Africa

During the month of November, the first Harvest Vision church family that was started in Kampala, Uganda years ago celebrated by every member and their family witnessing door-to-door and on the streets every Friday, Saturday and Sunday for 4 weeks. This is an example of the Holy Spirit teaching leaders in the church families that to deny themselves daily and to pick up their cross requires a transforming of the mind to be aligned to the Father's business of giving each human being the opportunity to hear the gospel: "That God so loved the world that He gave His One and Only Son that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. (Jonn 3:16). We thank God for our co-laborers in the harvest fields of central Africa whose lives, along with their families, testify to the freedom we find in being a true disciple of Jesus, allowing the Holy Spirit to teach us and then give us the power to overcome our own self-centeredness that minimizes or prevents us from being Christ-like and living to seek and save the lost.

Twenty years ago, the Lord brought Linda and me to meet Martin and his wife, Beatrice, their children and the Christian brothers and sisters they were in ministry with. We shared a common vision based on the words of the prophet Isaiah: "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you. Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn. The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is upon you to preach good news to the poor. He has sent you to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God".

The first years, we spent much time in prayer and visiting with different church leaders and families in central Africa seeking wisdom from the Lord and recognizing the need to have an apostolic presence in each area to help bring unity and coordinate evangelism, discipleship and the teaching of God's Word. As that vision was being revealed to us and as we began activating the vision, four years after we started, the Holy Spirit brought this young man, Kennedy, 23 years old, with his passion, love, creativity and energy ready and prepared to fan the flames that had already been ignited. He came with the same boldness, calling and faith that was given to us in the words of the prophet Isaiah. God appointed him just like he had appointed us, and the anointing has continued from that day and will continue until the last soul has been reached.

Kennedy served as technical coordinator for all the equipment and needs for the outreaches in Uganda, Kenya, South Sudan, DRCongo and Burundi. Always ready to help by sharing his knowledge or God's Word and love for Jesus with everyone God put in his path. His example of sacrifice for the sake of the gospel has been an ongoing example to everyone that had the opportunity to meet him personally. We have been blessed in these many years of fellowship with him and we have witnessed the expanding of his influence through his beautiful and God-fearing wife Joan and their three beautiful children. We know that because of Kennedy's example and inspiration the kingdom of heaven will continue to forcefully advance as forceful men like Kennedy lay hold of it. Recently, Kennedy our coordinator in Kaliro, Uganda was in an accident which sent him into the presence of the Lord. He is no longer physically present in the life of his wife, three children and the many church families that he was a part of. He was constantly in prayer and seeking to evangelize every community the Lord sent him to and taught many of the believers in these communities to reach out with the gospel message. The church had already planned their next outreach. Kennedy purchased a motorbike and would send believers to pray and fast in the community, then transport their power amp to the location to support 6 days of door-to-door and crusades before gathering the new believers on the next Sunday. Each day they had to take the power amp to a community that had power to charge it and during the week they used the motorbike to transport older and sick people to the crusades and meetings. In the accident that the Lord used to promote Kennedy, he and another brother were returning to the location of a new church family following 5 days of door-to-door ministry, for their first service. The motorbike and power amp were damaged beyond use and we have been blessed already with the finances to replace them and to help his wife and their three children. And that outreach that was planned has been completed. Praise God!

We thank God for the love and joy found in the Body of Christ that produces such peace and purpose as every day and in every way, the testifying, whether in the neighborhood, school, market place, door-to-door or other missions gives the believers the love and faith that over-shadows the pain, suffering and troubles that we face during our journey of life in this world. Even at this moment, the Bible schools are ongoing, the crusades, discipleship training, sharing with one another to meet every need, worship, praying and fasting. Yesterday, Martin along with 5 other coordinators, traveled to South Africa to teach in "Discipleship on Wheels", which is coordinated by a ministry in the USA. And all the vision and work that each of these coordinators has been a part of continues in their absence and would continue even if they physically did not return because they would still be a part of the true Body of Christ.
