Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back; lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes. For you will spread out to the right and to the left; your descendants will dispossess nations and settle in their desolate cities. Do not be afraid; you will not suffer shame. Do not fear disgrace; you will not be humiliated.” (Isaiah 54:1-4)

Many thanks to our many co-laborers in Christ that we have been blessed to fellowship with locally in our surrounding communities in northwest Washington and around the world. And, although we have been through different seasons of ministry, we have witnessed the expanding of gospel to other parts of the world as the body of Christ has grown stronger to fulfill the vision of Jesus Christ. “And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.” (Matthew 24:14)

After 47 years of serving the Lord out of our homes in Sedro Woolley and now the last 3 ½ years here at the Garden of Eden in Mount Vernon, with this beautiful property, garden, petting zoo, playground, picnic area and fellowship center, the Lord is asking us to remove the attention off the location of where he has planted us, to the obscurity of love and service. We will be living in Birdsvew, but our spiritual home is now residing in the different communities in our area and the families that God has appointed to serve there. So our work will be as Paul or Jesus writing their letters to the home church families of Mount Vernon, Burlington, Clear Lake, Lyman, Hamilton, Birdsvew, Concrete, Marblemount, Newhalem, Alger, Anacortes, Oak Harbor, Arlington, and others. We will be serving those in our community that God has appointed to reach those in the community where they live so they can do the part God has assigned with the understanding that if one part of the Body suffers, we all suffer. If one part is honored, we will all rejoice.

We are grateful for having had the opportunity to live on this property and to have the Garden available to us and for the relationships we have been given because of it. It has also given those in our sphere of influence 3 ½ years to make their decision and use that opportunity to make their own choice and everyone has. Jesus gave those that followed Him that same opportunity, responsibility and choice and He was not angry because they chose to stay with the religion that they trusted and neither is He now. Many are called and few are chosen. We know this 3 ½ years was also given to us, to examine the cost that would be required to “deny ourselves and pick up our cross daily and follow Him.” We know that the letters that Paul and Jesus wrote were not written to a pastor, denomination or program and that during the persecution believers met together in the homes of believers that God appointed for the purpose

of showing the unconditional love of the Father through Jesus Christ to everyone.

Harvest Vision Ministries will continue to serve financially to continue and expand the mission work and provide support to the church families as they grow and share with each other. We will be available to prepare and equip each one for the work that God has prepared in advance for them to do through the God appointed leadership He has entrusted to us in the New Testament.

So...after persecution began (Acts 8:1-4), everyone except the apostles were scattered throughout the communities. And those that were scattered preached the Word wherever they went.

The “Church” is God’s gift to the communities where He has placed His children to serve and love those that God also placed in that particular community.

This is a description of the new testament church during persecution.

“All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they shared everything they had. With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and much grace was upon them all. There were no needy persons among them.” (Acts 4:32-34)

Oh, sweet Jesus thank you for this month that you have given us. It was quite an adventure. Harvest Kids is always a mystery. Not knowing what God will bring. But that’s how it should be always a mystery. There is no revelation without a mystery. The Harvest Kids are currently at \$1,084 for the children’s church in Busolwe in eastern Uganda, Africa. It has been a blessed time to watch the Harvest Kids crush aluminum cans. Helping Comfort Africa meet the needs of vulnerable orphaned children and families. We have been working on moving upriver. Harvest Kids is still going to be at the Garden of Eden in Mount Vernon for the time being. Once the Garden of Eden fellowship center is not available, we will be moving into a more adjustable schedule for the Harvest Kids.

Knowing, not all the Harvest Kids can meet on Saturday at a specific time. We will have it one whatever day fits best for them and in their very own hometown, we will have Harvest Kids. Jesus does make house calls. He met people where they were at. And that’s what the Harvest Kids will be doing. Impacting the very people in their neighborhood. Fulfilling the scripture that Paul charged Timothy with: “Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.” (1 Timothy 4:2). Drop off locations for empty aluminum cans will be scattered around Skagit Valley. Information will be given as we move forward with the big shift going on. I am excited to see what God will do. God is good all the time. Thank you to all for taking time to read this and for being a part of something greater than our own self-centeredness.

Mexico

We are so thankful for Miguel and Olivia and their willingness to be available to different church families in San Luis, Rio Colorado, Sonora state next to the border south of the Yuma. They also support missions and missionaries that work in different states throughout Mexico. This are some of the testimonies she recently shared with us.

The Manantial de Vida (Fountain of Water) church family used the ministry van to go to Camp United in Christ at Rumorosa in Baja California. We have been getting together with the Puerta Estrecha (Narrow Door) church family and for prayer meetings for our city and the needs of our community. Miguel has been also sharing the Word there. We have also been working more closely with the Bethesda church family, sharing the Word and helping the Mission for Mexico team from Oregon in preparation for their house building ministry in March. For the last few years, I have ,Olivia, translated and set with their group as they review applications and interview families to find the families that have the greatest need. I also just finished the kids lessons about the Holy Ghost at Voz Que Clama en Desierto (Voice Calling in the Desert) church family and on October 18th, we had our city-wide Harvest Women's fellowship.

In Guerrero where Obed and Zury and their family serve, they have been working visiting many families which have members that are not able to move a lot because of terminal illness, They share the Word of God and visit and fellowship with them as they have time and the money for fuel for the car for those that are a distance away. They are working with a movie night as an outreach and five people have accepted Christ through this outreach. One person said he was interested but had many doubts and now Obed is working with him because he is desiring to know more about God's Word and His promises. Whenever the rain and road conditions do not prevent safe travel, they have been taking the Word of God to the missions of the Tuba and Huizataro. Most of the people in these two mountain villages do not read and they are seeking diligently that one of them or someone else would come and help shepherd the believers. Obed has also been called to speak at funerals, sharing the message of God with the relatives of the deceased and some of them have accepted Jesus through His sharing. Praise God!

After receiving this testimony from Olivia, on behalf of our co-laborers in the USA that support their work in Mexico, we are increasing the monthly donations to help Obed and his family with the gas needed to continue their mission to their communities.

Africa

Many thanks to each of you that pray and provide support for our co-laborers in the harvest fields of central Africa. A short time ago, a severe windstorm blew across eastern Uganda demolishing the gathering place of the believers in Kadama. Other church families from different areas began to prepare a new construction outreach to support the community. They sent 6 believers to go and fast and do prayer walks and they were joined with 70 other believers from different church families in central and eastern Uganda that came to help with construction and after a week of door-to-door ministry the construction was complete and 349 new believers had been added to the church family. Preparations were made to baptize them and believers from other church families that helped will stand with them as they begin the discipleship of the new believers. This last week, thanks to another co-laborer from the USA and the help of the Love Benti ministry from Taiwan, one of the communities in eastern Uganda, where there is a Harvest Vision church family that Harvest Kids from the USA has been helping with children and youth ministry had a new well drilled and now have safe water to take care of their needs. The old well had stopped providing water a few years ago.

Also, the leaders of the ministry in South Sudan have been given the vision to begin a new church family to a people group farther north in the desert. One of the believers has been called to go and evangelize and shepherd the new believers and our Harvest Vision co-laborers from the USA sent the funding needed to equip him for the mission. The outreach ministry package is all solar and has the material in the languages of the tribes that he will be witnessing to. Martin, the director of Harvest Vision in Africa, had the privilege of visiting and meeting the founders of the ministry that provides these fully contained packs while he was on his mission to Georgia in the USA. We would appreciate your continued prayers and if possible, your financial support to reach everyone in central Africa and the whole world with the good news of the gospel.

During the month of September, we ended up with our Africa co-laborers coordinating 31 outreaches and another thousand believers have been swept up in the Father's loving arms and are being discipled by local believers until they are grounded in a strong church family. During the month of November, the first Harvest Vision church family that was started in Kampala, will celebrate by every member and their family witnessing door-to-door and on the streets every Friday, Saturday and Sunday for 4 weeks.

The Bible schools scattered throughout the areas are started in a central location where leaders can attend and receive training and normally do not have to travel more than 50 kilometers. They attend 2-3 days each month and then return to their families and other ministry responsibilities, reviewing with other students that are close to them and teaching the leaders in their church families what they are learning. The Bible school in Burundi just presented 100 leaders with certificates this month.

"Then Jesus came to them and said, 'All authority in heaven and one earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.'" (Mt 28:18-20) "and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (Acts 1:8b)
