### **Harvest Vision Fellowship Curlew, WA & Harvest Vision Blue Creek, Chewelah, WA**

We appreciate everyone that supports the ministry that John and Lena do in the communities of Republic, Curlew and the surrounding areas and Jarett & Brianna are doing in Chewelah and Colville in northern & eastern Washington. We have been able to bring food and clothes donated in Skagit County that they distribute to local ministries and others in need in their community and provide a new freezer for their ministry. John & Lena will be drilling a well on their property north of Curlew and will be building housing for the ministry. They have also been given the opportunity to be the caregivers and have over-sight for a 22 ½ acre farm and slaughterhouse in Curlew. Jarett, Brianna and their children have been involved in ministry in California and are now in Chewelah. They are preparing to purchase a commercial lot in downtown Colville to build a Christian coffee house for bringing the Body of Christ together to help share the love of Jesus to those that are broken hearted and crushed in spirit in their community. We are looking forward to the fullness of the vision that God has given to them.

### **Mexico and Central America**

We are so thankful for the ministry that Miguel and Olivia are able to do in San Luis, Sonora, Mexico and Obed and Zury are able to do in Guerrero in south Mexico during the restrictions being imposed by the Mexican government. In San Luis, besides Miguel working at the cable company 6 days a week, they have tambourine dance practice on Monday; outreach at the local park or a prayer meeting with other church families on Tuesday; women's bible study at Voz que Clama with Pr. Ariel or at the Harvest mission home on Wednesday; ministry at the convalescent center or prayer meeting with Pr. Ariel every Thursday; visitations with different families on Friday and Sunday morning service at Voz que Clama in the morning and the Harvest mission home in the evenings. We are in constant prayer for those that are struggling with sickness and for the full opening of the border to allow non-essential travel. George and Noe will be visiting from Washington August 16-23 to discuss future teams to Mexico and expanding the ministry to other states in Mexico and to Central America and to deliver solar powered Spanish audio bibles that will be used in San Luis and Guerrero. Olivia and their son, Yvann, will be returning to Washington on August 24 and stay until September 8. We will also be discussing a trip with Noe, Miguel and Olivia to Guerrero in mid November.

In Guayameo, the small village in Guerrero, where Obed and Zury do ministry they have two services every Sunday morning. Many of the people in this area live scattered in the mountains and some are unable to read. During the morning they have Bible study and during the evening they have a worship service with the sharing of the word. On Tuesday, they visit one of the two missions that are located about an hour from their village. They have prayer meeting on Wednesday, Bible study on Friday and visit believers and non-believers on the other days.

We are thankful for all the ministry that Pr. Sergio is doing in El Salvador. The growth of the church fellowship in Ciudad Arce by Santa Ana is expanding and Sergio is also able to visit other areas in the countries as the Spirit leads. We were blessed to send 30 solar powered audio bibles in Spanish to Sergio for outreach. We are hoping to identify more brothers and sisters from El Salvador that live in Washington so Pr. Sergio can begin a relationship with them and be an encouragement to everyone.

### **Africa**

We are thankful, that even though Uganda is still under extended lockdown and all the borders adjacent to Uganda have been closed, the other countries are not as severely impacted. In Burundi, outreaches and bible schools are ongoing. South Sudan, Kenya and the DR Congo are still doing door to door and other ministry and many new church families are being started. We are thankful to have received funding from the USA to replace sound equipment in Burundi and the DR Congo. The gospel continued throughout June but we have not received these testimonies because Suzan, our admin coordinator, had a problem during her pregnancy that required an emergency C-section. We are grateful that they were close to the hospital and the baby was born healthy. The weekly radio shows from David in north Uganda and Charles in central Uganda are still reaching many with the gospel message. The listeners contact the radio station and many have accepted Christ and are followed up by other believers. The word of God can not be chained. The lockdown in Uganda, which limits personal transportation, is especially devastating in the city of Kampala with almost 4 million people. They have already been severely affected because of the lack of work and now there is no money and no transportation other than walking to find the limited food available. Obviously, that circumstance doesn't affect most people in the city because they have no money. Fortunately, some people were able to leave the congested city before the lockdown to their villages where there is food available. We are thankful for the co-laborers from the USA that have responded and sent finances to help as many people as possible during this crisis.

Pastor Martin is continuing to pursue the starting of a macadamia tree farm, which has the long-term potential to provide the funds needed to support the over-all ministry in central Africa. That will allow any funding from the USA to be used for projects and expanding to other areas and countries. The project will start at 3 acres that are currently owned by Harvest Vision Africa in Mukono, outside of Kampala. The funding for the trees will come from the pineapple farm that was started a few years ago. That would sustain 100 trees per acre and also allow the land around the trees to be used for cultivating other crops such as beans, peanuts and casava during the 3-4 years it takes for the trees to mature. Another 30 acres will be purchased in northwest Uganda and the money needed (\$26,000) is available.

We are thankful that the construction on the Harvest Doves primary school in Kayunga in central Uganda is going forward. The school started with 80 primary students enrolled the first of June and 35 of the children were from Muslim households. We appreciate the ongoing support to finish the permanent structure and are anxious to provide an education and hopefully, salvation, for all these children and their families. The Harvest Kids in the USA, with support provided from an ongoing garage and produce sale will provide the remaining \$4,000 needed for the plaster and paint.

What an amazing month of ministry and miracles in our community as we witness the Lord shaking up everything in heaven and on earth to bring His Church together with Jesus as head and the Holy Spirit as the only true worship leader. We appreciate everyone who prays with and for Harvest Vision Ministries and our co-laborers, locally and around the world, to bring us together in unity so the whole world will know that the Father sent Jesus to reconcile the world to Himself not holding their sins against them. The month has been filled with opportunities to see the love of Jesus shining brightly from those that have chosen to deny themselves and pick up their cross daily and follow Jesus into the lives of people that are broken hearted and crushed in spirit. The perfect love that drives out all fear. We are praying that the Lord will bring an increase of those that would help provide the finances to continue and expand the ministry. There is information on how anyone wanting to help can donate in this newsletter or on the website. The website giving form has been revised to give donors the option to pay the additional process fee for their donation.

The Harvest Home in Sedro Woolley is a buzz of activity as we are hosting an ongoing garage and fresh produce sale every Tuesday – Saturday through the end of August. This helps raise money to support the Harvest Kids desire to finish another new school for orphans and other vulnerable children in Africa. So far the garage sale has raised over \$6,000. This Christian school was started on June 6<sup>th</sup> with 80 children and 35 are children from local Muslim families in the community. So many people coming every day to donate items, purchase fresh produce coming from the Garden of Eden farm in Mt. Vernon, share testimonies, pray together and encourage and be encouraged by other believers. Soon, everyone will be able to buy delicious sweet corn a local farmer has planted and made available for the Harvest Kids ministry. The Harvest Home is available for fellowship and to support the work of those doing ministry throughout the community. It also is a place for home church fellowship, devotions and prayer.

The Garden of Eden family ministry is expanding with the help of a Christian couple and their children that have come to live at the home and support the over-all ministry. With favorable weather, we have been able to do worship outside using the worship trailer. We have hosted church fellowship in the fellowship center and all night “Prayer for all Nations” gatherings. The fellowship center is now being redesigned to accommodate home school starting in the fall. Work has started on adding a petting zoo on site for the families in our community that come to enjoy the playground, sports activities, picnic and camping opportunity. Many also come to help weed and work in the garden area, which will soon host an orchard, greenhouse and bees for making honey.

We are blessed with the privilege of praying, encouraging and financially supporting our Harvest Vision coordinators that are evangelizing, teaching and helping provide basic needs to their communities, locally in Washington, Mexico, Central America and seven countries in central Africa. We are also able to provide support to individuals and ministries that are not directly involved Harvest Vision Ministries, locally and throughout the world.

The Harvest Kids continue to meet the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of each month to check on the Harvest Rabbits and Cats, crush cans that have been donated and donate their change to help finish the school they are helping build for vulnerable children in central Uganda. With the help of the garage sale and from other donors they have funded \$16,117 of the money to refurbish the old building and start the school and only need \$4,083 to complete the entire project. Wow, what a bunch of heroes of the faith! Now, when they come they can help set up and be involved in the ongoing garage and produce sale. A few weeks ago, they set up a refreshment table with iced water and cookies for people that stop by. The day is filled with welcoming new kids, games, sharing testimonies and learning God’s Word and how it defines who we are and what God wants us to do to give Him glory. It is a blessing to share the love of Jesus and help them to become true disciples by teaching them to be “givers” instead of “takers”, becoming “selfless” instead of “selfish”. They truly have the joy of the Lord in their lives. We are so thankful for the last 8 years being with these young disciples from our community and for everyone that supports them.
